## **EFRAG – the Swedish Financial Reporting Board**

### **Outreach event on the Future Agenda of the IASB**

**9 November 2011 in Stockholm**

EFRAG and the Swedish Financial Reporting Board organise their joint outreach event on the IASB post-convergence Agenda Consultation. The event will be held in a round table format. Observers are also welcome to attend. The purpose of the event is to gather useful input to help the IASB in the determination of its future agenda and priority setting for the development of amended and new standards. In July of this year the IASB put out a consultation paper on this subject asking for views from constituents and interested parties. The IASB, representatives of which will be attending as well, believes that an extensive due process in this respect is necessary to ensure that its future agenda meets with needs perceived in practice. EFRAG issued its Draft Comment Letter on 11 August with a deadline for comment of 15 November. The EFRAG Draft Comment Letter will be part of the discussions.
